Any South African citizen who has a valid passport with an expiration date of more than 6 months from the date of their trip does not need to obtain a visa prior to travel. You will be issued one upon your arrival.



TIME LIMIT?
Yes, there is a 3 month limit and your return ticket must be dated before this time.
