# Christianity in Israel

**Christianity** is practiced by more than 161,000 Israeli citizens (about 2.1% of population).



*Israel is the only country in the Middle East  
with Freedom of Religion for all*



# Christians under Palestinian Rule



Approximately 10% of the Palestinian population in Judea and Samaria were Christians in the 1990s. The updated number of Christians under the Palestinian Authority today is 1% of the population.

# Christians under Palestinian Rule

Since the Hamas takeover of the Gaza Strip in 2006, anti-Christian attitudes have been on the increase.

In 2005 there were 3,000 Christians in Gaza. Today, only a few hundred remain in the Gaza Strip .

# Temple Mount



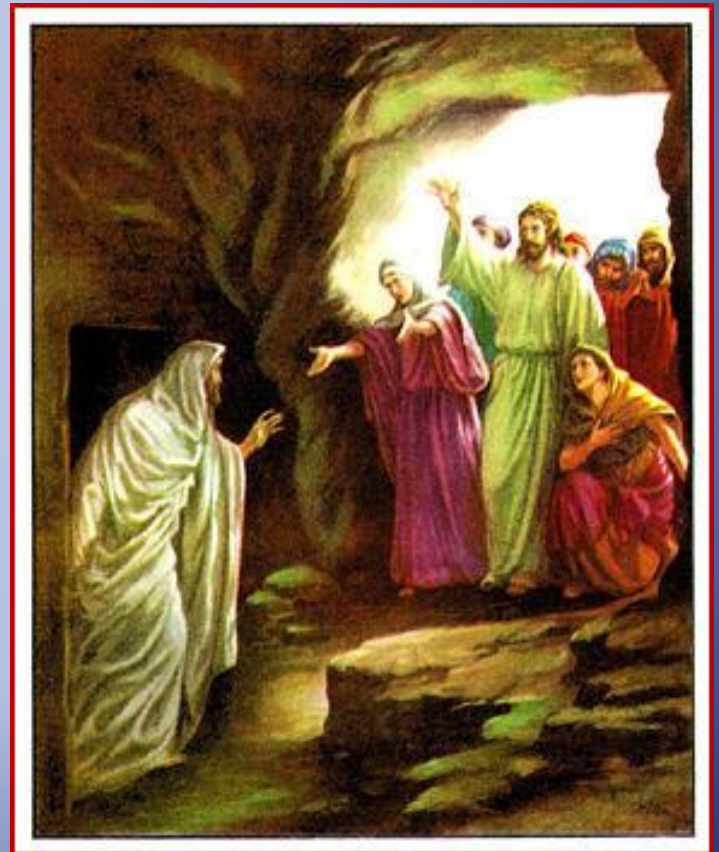
John 7:14 - Now about the midst of the feast

# In Palestinian Territories

*February 2003, Shehem, The Tomb of Joseph* being destroyed by PLO activists. Today it is under a mosque.

*September 18, 2006, Tulkerem—* Two churches were set afire in response to comments regarding the nature of Islam by **Pope Benedict XVI** .



*Jun 18, 2007, Gaza* - Christians in Gaza fear for their lives as Muslims burn bibles and destroy crosses. They have issued an appeal to the international community and a plea for protection against the increased attacks by Muslim extremists.

*November 5, 2012 – Pakistan: A church was burned while Muslims were protesting a film that carried material objectionable to Islam.*



*August 2013-Current –  
Egypt: Dozens of churches  
have been destroyed, over  
500 dead, and 3,000 injured.*
